Confessional formulations of the Councils of Toledo 9. Missionary work in Western Europe from the 7th to the 9th century. 10. The Confession of faith of Charlemagne. 11. Symbol of faith in the Roman Church after 1054. 12. Augsburg Confession (1530). 13. Confession of faith at the Council of Trent. 14. The Anglican Catechism. 15. Modern interpretations of the Symbols of faith in the East and the West.		
Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	Utilizing narrative sources together with a historical analysis of the historical context in which confessional formulations arise. Translation of the untranslated confessions from the ancient Greek and Latin, and the comparative analysis of the Confessions of faith for the same periods, but from different geographical regions.
