Course objectives	The course objective is to acquire knowledge of the Church-Slavonic language relevant to the professional competence of theologians of linguistic and translation competence in an operational dimension (application of acquired knowledge and skills in the reception Church-Slavonic text in the translation process).		
Learning outcomes	Attainment of theoretical-methodological competences in the field of structural-semantic analysis of the Church-Slavonic text so as to be able to effect adequate transposition into the Serbian standard language; familiarity with the lexical-phraseological, grammatical and stylistic problems of translation; possession of skills most relevant to translation techniques, and the ability to use lexicographic manuals.

Lectures	Definition of Church-Slavonic. Church-Slavonic as a liturgical language. Church-Slavonic language throughout history. Church-Slavonic language of the Serbs. Church-Slavonic alphabet. The basic rules of reading. Phonetic-phonological system of Church-Slavonic language. Morphological system of Church-Slavonic language. Types of words: classification; general grammatical meaning and partial grammatical categories, lexical-grammatical groups, forms (paradigmatic types). Word formation in the Church-Slavonic language. The syntax of the Church-Slavonic language. Lexicon of the Church-Slavonic language. Church-Slavonic language today: functional and sociolinguistic aspects.		
Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	Interpretation of selected texts. Phonetic, graphic-orthographic and morphological analysis of selected texts. Derivatological, etymological, syntactic, lexical, and generative analysis of selected texts.
