Course objectives	Introduction to the conceptual-categorical and methodological apparatus of the New Testament Exegesis, mastering the skills of interpretation of the New Testament content through competent independent synchronous / diachronic work on (selected) texts, designed to train candidates for the effective application of the New Testament messages.

Introduction to the New Testament Exegesis: Theological Argumentation; 2. the historical development of the New Testament exegesis with a special emphasis on the contributions of Serbian exegetical traditions; 3. exegetical analysis of selected sections of the historical texts of the New Testament literature: Mk 1: 21-28; Mt 1-2; 3: 1-17; 5: 1-10; 6: 9-13; 12: 22-32; 17: 1-9; 26: 17-36; 26: 37-27: 66; Lk 15: 11-32; 18: 9-14; Jn 1: 1- 18; 2: 1-11; 5: 1-18; 20-21; Acts 2; 4. Exegetical analysis of selected sections of the New Testament epistolography: 1 Cor 13: 1-13; Eph 5: 23-33; Rev 1-21.			
Practical classes (exercises, additional forms of classes, research work)	Processing of the same thematic units from the applicative aspect, with emphasis on analyzing and interpreting the selected New Testament texts, as well as training for the active and productive use of literature through the production of translations from a foreign language, presenting exegetical topics and problems within the framework of exercises or independent seminar work.
