Course objectives	<p>The aim of the teaching is to form relevant, for professional competency of the theologian, communicative, linguistic, linguistic-cultural and traductological skills in the use of Russian language in the sphere of academic everyday life, inter-Church communication, sociocultural and professional sphere. This goal involves acquiring operational knowledge about the Russian sacral functional-stylistic complex, building the ability of adequate reception and translating informative, publicistic and administrative-business texts, training for informative, studious and diagonal reading, building the ability to understand by hearing, as well as training for producing oral (dialogical and monologic) and written reports from the listed spheres of communication.</p>		
Learning outcomes	<p>By mastering the basics of intercultural communication, the student is capable of written and oral reception and production in the field of academic everyday life, inter-Church communication, socio-cultural and professional sphere at the level of the international standard B1 + - B2, as well as for translation of informative, publicistic, general and administrative-business texts with the help of the dictionary.</p>
